



Directions

You will be going to the Main Legislative Building at Queen's Park.

- From Hwy. 401: Exit at Avenue Road (Exit 367). Continue South - follow signs indicating 11A. Avenue Rd. becomes Queen's Park Crescent, South of Bloor St.
- From QEW / Gardiner Expressway: Exit at York St. Continue North at Front St., veer left onto University Ave. University Ave. leads directly to Queen's Park.
- From the Don Valley Expressway: Follow Bloor/Bayview exit. Follow exit to Bloor St. Turn right onto Bloor St. and continue to Avenue Rd./Queen's Park intersection. Turn left and continue South.

Parking & Arrival Information

There is no parking at the Legislative building. Street parking is located on streets adjacent to the building, and public parking lots are available within a 10 minute walk of the Legislative Assembly (fees range from \$5 to \$20). Paid parking is located at U. of Toronto, just to the West of QP, as well as off Wellesley, between QP Crescent and Bay St. on the South side, and underground parking is also available under the Macdonald Block (between Queen's Park Crescent and Bay Street). You can enter *any* entrance up until 6pm. After 6pm, you can only enter the South/basement entrance, (also for wheelchair access), which is just to the left of the main entrance and is open 24 hrs.

No matter which entrance you go to, you will pass a security post, where a guard will require your full name and give you a pass for the evening. They can also direct you to the committee rooms, which are located on the 2nd floor. See you there!
