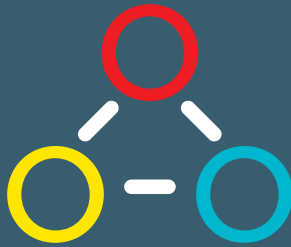

The co-operative business model has been around since the nineteenth century, but co-operative knowledge is always evolving.

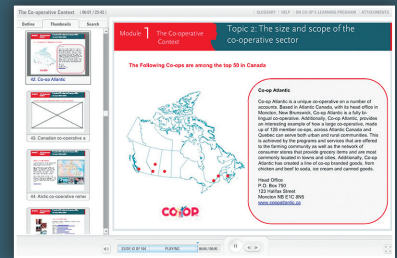
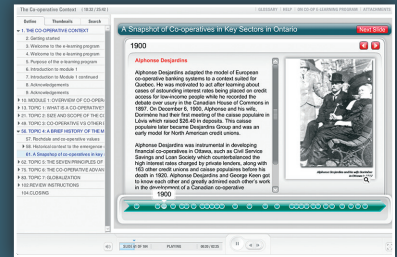

- Once you have registered for your courses, you may access them again and again from any computer with an Internet connection, for as long as you remain subscribed to the Learning Management System.
